#### The Year in Review

With the generous support of our funders and partners, 2024 was a year of growth at ABLE, as we continued to implement our five-year strategic plan to expand and enhance our services for people who are blind or otherwise print disabled.

ABLE continued to produce audiobooks in the ABLE Sound Center that meet the rigorous digital recording standards of the National Library Service. Emphasizing Wisconsin authors, ABLE records books for both children and adults. In addition to books, ABLE produces other audio resources that help blind and print disabled people participate more fully in community life, including schedules for Summerfest, the Wisconsin State Fair, and Irish Fest, as well as a monthly recording of *Milwaukee Magazine*. In 2024 we also produced a Handbook for Borrowers and a DVD catalog for the Wisconsin Talking Book and Braille Library.

ABLE upheld its commitment to meet individual needs for both braille and audio, transcribing items such as books with knitting patterns, healthy eating guides, memoirs, and job training materials.

In 2024 ABLE's team of staff and volunteers produced 16,445 pages of brailled learning materials for students, including 2,384 tactile diagrams (raised line drawings). Each page that ABLE produces signifies another opportunity for blind students to have a level playing field with their sighted peers.

We continued our initiative to get more books into the hands of blind children throughout Wisconsin. Based on the feedback we have received, we believe these books are encouraging braille reading skills and inspiring blind children with the courage, insight, and resilience of the books' blind protagonists. ABLE also produces braille materials for the broader community, including programs for the Milwaukee Symphony Orchestra and the Marcus Performing Arts Center and ballots for the Milwaukee County Election Commission. We produced over 6,800 pages of braille materials for adults last year.

We are so grateful for the commitment of all our stakeholders who work with us to enhance literacy, dignity, productivity, and independence for people in our community who are blind, visually impaired, or print disabled.
